Training to Work – Adult Reentry

AGENCY: Employment and Training Administration, Department of Labor

ACTION: Amendment to SGA/DFA PY 12-06

SUMMARY: The Employment and Training Administration announced on March 18, 2013 the availability of funds and Solicitation for Grant Applications (SGA) for Training to Work – Adult Reentry grants to be awarded through a competitive process. This amendment to the SGA amends language in Section IV.B.3. The document is hereby amended as follows:

Section IV.B.3.1(6th bullet) NEED AND JUSTIFICATION FOR NUMBER OF PARTICIPANTS TO BE SERVED (new language in bold)

Old Text:

- The number of participants the applicant plans to serve and documentation that there are sufficient eligible offenders in state and/or local work release programs to justify the number of participants based upon the number of offenders enrolled in state and/or local work release programs for the previous year. The number of participants to be served must be greater than or equal to the number of adults enrolled in state and/or local work-release programs in the target area in the previous year. See Section III. C.3 for definition of eligible participants. The applicant must document the source of its data on the number of adults enrolled in state and/or local work release programs.

New Text:

- The number of participants the applicant plans to serve and documentation that there are sufficient eligible offenders in state and/or local work release programs to justify the number of participants based upon the number of offenders enrolled in state and/or local work release programs for the previous year. The number of participants to be served must be **less** than or equal to the number of adults enrolled in state and/or local work-release programs in the target area in the previous year. See Section III. C.3 for definition of eligible participants. The applicant must document the source of its data on the number of adults enrolled in state and/or local work release programs.
