<b>Project Description</b>	Connecticut, through its Office of Apprenticeship Training, will implement a manufacturing-focused State Registered Apprenticeship Development Model to generate a greater number of registered apprentices in manufacturing occupations throughout the State. Connecticut expects that increasing the number of Registered Apprenticeship sponsors builds capacity statewide for current and future on-the-job training (OJT) programs and provides a mechanism for sustainability of these job-driven programs. The State also plans to contract with three workforce investment boards to implement new and expanded OJT opportunities that target Science, Technology, Engineering and Math (STEM) occupations, with a particular focus on Engineering, Information Technology, and Advanced Manufacturing. The State also plans to continue Career Pathways in one local area.
